Day 1 July 13, Friday: Depart USA

Depart New York's JFK International Airport on Air France for our overnight flight to Paris, CDG Airport.

Dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served in-flight.

Day 2 July 14, Saturday: Arrive Paris | Orientation Tour of Paris | Bastille Day Celebrations

Arrive at Paris CDG International Airport. Go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and our Peter's Way tour manager will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board our private coach bus and soon we will be on our way to Paris - the 'City of Lights'. Independent Lunch. Our journey begins as we take the elevators at the Eiffel Tower to the second floor. The lifts will make their way through its iron skeleton to bring us to the second floor for a breathtaking view of Paris! With more than 6 million visitors each year, it is one of the most visited monuments in France. Check-in at our hotel in Paris. This evening, we will experience the celebration of Bastille Day in Paris!

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris.

Day 3 July 15, Sunday: Highlights of Paris including Montmartre | Cruise on the Seine

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. We begin our day with a visit to the Ile de la Cité where we'll find the **Cathedral Notre-Dame de Paris**, a jewel of gothic art. Discover this unique site which is still a place of rich spirituality with around twenty priests ordained each year. Continue to visit **Sainte Chapelle** (Holy Chapel) a hidden treasure on the island of the Ile de la Cité. It was built to hold holy relics such as the Crown of Thorns which was acquired by French king Louis IX. Next we visit the **Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal**, a high spiritual Parisian place where several apparitions of the Virgin Mary took place in 1830. These apparitions are recognized by the Church. One can invoke the Virgin Mary with this prayer: "O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee". While there, discover the life of Saint Catherine Labouré to whom the Virgin Mary appeared. Each pilgrim can pray in the same spot of the apparitions or in front of the Saint's reliquary. Just a few blocks away, discover the **Church of Saint Vincent de Paul** which house the relics of the Saint. Independent lunch. Discover the **Basilica of the Sacred Heart** and an amazing view of Paris. The basilica was constructed because of a vow that was made after France was defeated in the Franco-Prussian War. Alexander Legentil and Hubert de Fleury believed that the misfortunes, which fell upon France, happened because of spiritual reasons. As a result, they vowed to build a church, which would be dedicated to the Sacred Heart. This church is the Basilica of the Sacred Heart on Montmartre. This project was seen as atonement as well as a force of hope and spiritual renewal. Parisian and French Christians pledge to maintain a permanent 24/7 prayer in exchange for the protection of Paris. In 1872, the archbishop of Paris approved the project and chose the hill of Montmartre for the site. The financing of the edifice was through individual gifts (often modest ones) from people all over France. Their names are engraved in the stone of the basilica. For over a century, Parisians and pilgrims from all over the world relay to maintain the permanent prayer. *Sunday Mass and possibility of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and of a meeting with one of the sisters that welcome the pilgrims.* Afterwards, we will board the famous Parisian "bateaux-mouches" for an unforgettable 60-minute cruise on the river Seine!

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris.

Day 4 July 16, Monday: Full day Excursion to Lisieux

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. This morning we will drive two hours to visit the **Sanctuary of Lisieux**. While there, we will discover the **Basilica** and watch a movie about the life of Saint Therese. Saint Therese is known as a doctor of the Church and affectionately called "the little Therese" by pilgrims who appreciate her for her gospel simplicity. Visit the "**Buissonnets**", the family home where Saint Therese spent her childhood, and discover the **Carmelite convent** where she remained cloistered until her death. Have a time of prayer by her relics at her shrine. Afterwards, visit the **Cathedral of Saint Peter** where the Martin family went regularly to mass. Celebrate **Mass in Lisieux**. Independent lunch in Lisieux. Return to Paris.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paris.

Day 5 July 17, Tuesday: Paris | Lourdes

After an early breakfast at the hotel, we will be transferred to Paris Orly Airport for our continuing flight to Lourdes Pyrenees Airport. Late in the morning we will arrive in Lourdes, claim our luggage, and be transferred to Lourdes. Lourdes is a town in southwestern France, in the foothills of the Pyrenees mountains. Pictures seldom reflect the magnitude of beauty which we will come across. A picture book castle and the "Grotto", where the "Beautiful Lady" appeared to Bernadette, visually dominate the town. Four to six million pilgrims from around the world visit the shrine each year and it is estimated that more than 200 million pilgrims have come to Lourdes since 1860. The exchanges with other pilgrims from around the world is the most touching part of the entire experience. Everyone seems imbued with a loving spirit that charges the atmosphere. At night, joyful singing fills the narrow streets. Whether visitors experience a healing miracle or not, most say the miracle comes simply by being in Lourdes. Check-in at our hotel. Freshen-up. **Celebrate Mass before dinner.** After dinner, we will join in the candlelight procession, recitation of the **Rosary and singing Hymns to honor the Mother of God.**

Overnight at our hotel in Lourdes.

Day 6 July 18, Wednesday: Lourdes

Breakfast at our hotel. **Mass at the Grotto** (To be confirmed. Liturgies at the Grotto are scheduled on the hour, 6:00 am to 7:00 pm, with the English Mass time advised two weeks prior to departure.) This morning, we will participate in a walking tour of Lourdes. We will visit places associated with the life of Bernadette such as the Boly Mill, where St. Bernadette was born; the Locale Mill, residence of her parents; the "Cochot," formerly used as a jail where she lived at the time of the Apparitions; the Chapel where St. Bernadette received her First Holy Communion; and the Parish church containing the Baptismal Font where she was baptized. Independent lunch. This afternoon is free for our private devotions, Stations of the Cross, visiting the Grotto and Miraculous Baths. There will be an opportunity to attend the blessing of the sick, one of the most inspiring events at the Shrine. **After dinner, join in the Torchlight Marian procession, praying the Rosary and singing hymns to honor the Mother of God.**

Overnight at the hotel in Lourdes.

Day 7 July 19, Thursday: Lourdes | Biarritz

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning, we will be transferred to the city of Biarritz, roughly two hours away. Independent lunch and check-in at our hotel. **Celebrate Mass in Biarritz.** Biarritz lies along the Basque coast, adjacent to Spain's Basque region, the influences of which are apparent in Biarritz's architecture and cuisine. A stretch of 5 beaches, each with a distinct history and flavor, comprise Biarritz, including the Cote de Basques Beach, the first European surfing hot spot discovered when American filmmaker Peter Viertel brought a longboard from California and surfed the crashing waves, astonishing locals. Among the local attractions is the old whaling port, which is reminiscent of an era when whaling was Biarritz's primary means of commerce, and nearby Port des Pecheurs, a small fishing port. Discover the city on our own, maybe take a walk down to the beach. Biarritz offers an amazing diversity of natural landscapes: from the tip of **Saint-Martin (Le Phare)** to the **Côte des Basques** by way of the **Grande-Plage**, the **Port des Pêcheurs** and the **Rocher de la Vierge**, the littoral is full of places to discover. Benches are set up all along the seafont for small breaks with stunning views.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Biarritz.

Day 8 July 20, Friday: Biarritz

Breakfast at our hotel. **Celebrate Mass in Biarritz.** After gaining popularity as the seaside resort town favored by French royalty, the village of Biarritz grew increasingly cosmopolitan, attracting international jet setters and gaining a reputation as "the queen of beaches and beach of kings." Biarritz's delightful beach, full of character, is perfect for swimming and surfing. An elegant seaside town on southwestern France's Basque coast, Biarritz has been a popular resort since European royalty began visiting in the 1800s. The town boasts a plethora of other activities. Lunch on our own. Spend our afternoon doing as we please.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Biarritz.

Day 9 July 21, Saturday: Biarritz | Lourdes

Breakfast at our hotel. Morning at leisure to spend as we wish. Perhaps visit the Aquarium of Biarritz, the Cite de l'Ocean et du Surf, Phare de Biarritz or Casino Barriere. There are plenty of options, as the city is filled with outdoor sights, museums, beaches and more. Independent lunch. Continue to Lourdes and check-in at our hotel. **Celebrate Mass before dinner. After dinner, we will join in the Torchlight Marian procession, praying the Rosary and singing hymns to honor the Mother of God.**

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lourdes.

Day 10 July 22, Sunday: Lourdes | Paris | USA

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Pau Airport for our Air France return flight via Paris. In the afternoon, we will arrive at New York's JFK International Airport.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. Package prices are \$100.00 higher per person when using a debit/credit card as form of payment as the package price shown on the brochure reflects a cash discount. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on the brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed, current, and in good condition. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip from New York JFK International Airport on Air France. Flight itinerary and carrier are subject to changes. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. This includes any flights booked within the group itinerary. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (\$2,195.00 per person sharing a room) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, at least 100 days prior to departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/ airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Double bedded rooms for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are usually not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at booking for an additional charge of \$650. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be away from the group in hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or on tour), we must charge the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities to the tour manager/guide, and driver are included in the package price. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave 1,00 Euro per person per day for the maid or housekeeper.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel; and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as our pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, which may involve stairs, hills, cobblestone roads and uneven pavement. Additionally, most motor coaches are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. It is each passenger's responsibility to be aware of his or her limits with regard to travel and group activities. Any person with a disability requiring special attention must advise Peter's Way Tours of the situation at time of enrollment. A qualified companion must accompany any passenger requiring special assistance. Peter's Way Tours will make reasonable attempts to accommodate disabled passengers with special needs, but shall not be held responsible in the event we are unable to do so. Moreover, Peter's Way Tours is not responsible for the denial of services by any carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants purchase insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for non-refundable payments, damaged luggage or trip interruption. Peter's Way Tours offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan that provides coverage for pre-paid travel arrangements made through Peter's Way Tours. These benefits and services help insure the well being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc. **The insurance premium for total package prices from \$0 to \$1000.00 is \$100; \$1001.00 to \$2000.00 is \$175; \$2001.00 to \$3000.00 is \$225; \$3001.00 to \$4000.00 is \$250; \$4001.00 to \$5000.00 is \$275; and \$5001.00 and over is 6% of total package price.
